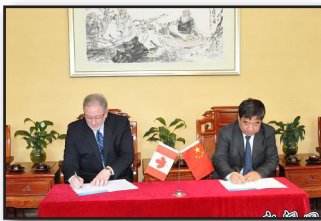
### **Vice President meets with the delegation from University of Windsor**

Vice president Neil Gold, in charge of international relations at University of Windsor, Canada; Professor Alan Conway, Dean of Business School; and Professor Tony Dickson from the GLOBAL Higher Education Consultant company visited UIBE.



The University of Windsor was founded in 1857. It is located in the city of Windsor, which is the industrial center of North American Midwest Great Lakes. The University of Windsor currently has 13,000 students including 70 Chinese students.

This visit marks the second time Vice President Golden visits following at UIBE's invitation, in order to further discuss cooperation between the two schools. UIBE's Vice President Lin Guijun introduced UIBE. The two schools decided to start the cooperation by exchanging students, scholars, and academics. Following the discussion, Vice President Lin and Vice President Golden signed a memorandum of cooperation.
