

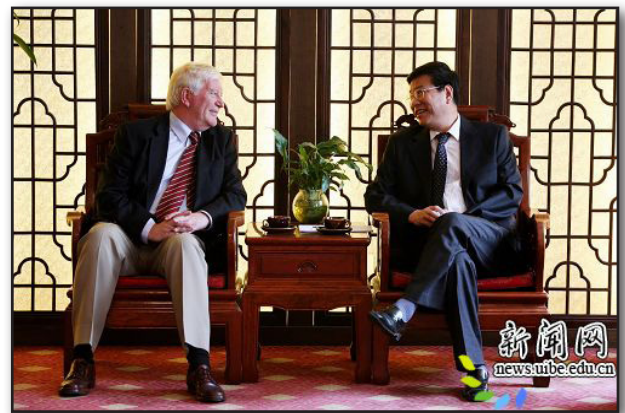

Also, recently Australia held the first Chinese Language and Culture Festival, a second one is to be organized in October, and again 2011 is the China Year in Australia; the government of Melbourne and Australia hope more that more Chinese scholars, cultural organizations, exchange delegations will visit Australia to promote the exchange of culture and business between China and Australia. Australia's government also invited UIBE.

For next years events UIBE pledged to sending Business Chinese teachers and text books to help train Australian business people.

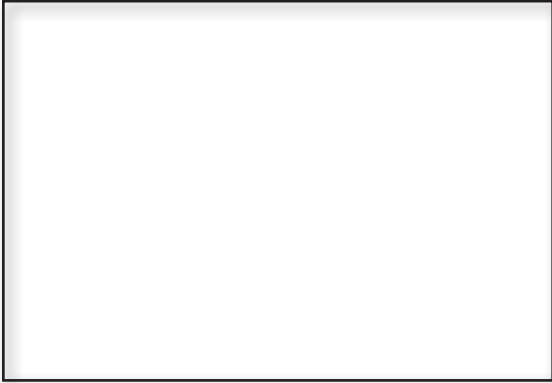
