UIBE's President Shi Jianjun Visits 6 British Universities



President Shi Jianjun and his delegation visited the University of Warwick, the University of Manchester, the University of Salford, the University of Leeds, the University of Birmingham, and the Royal Holloway University of London.

The University of Warwick

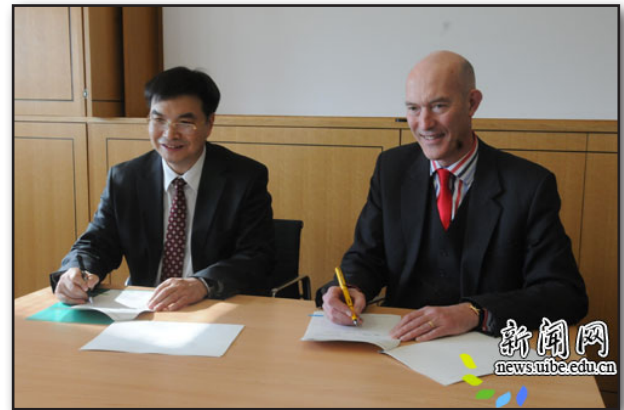
President Shi visited the University of Warwick and met with the president Pro. Nigel Thrift and signed a Memorandum agreeing to the training of UIBE post-graduates in intercultural business communication. The project will begin in 2011. UIBE's School of International Trade & Economics (SITE) will work together with Warwick's Business School, doing research in international business, financial markets, and exchange teachers.

Visiting Warwick's Business School UIBE reached a preliminary agreement to cooperate in energy research projects, and joint training doctoral students, MBA students overseas internships and teacher training. Warwick's Business School has 8,000 students. It

has a lot of partner universities in Europe, India, the middle East and America.

A cooperation may with UIBE may be reached based on the following criteria:

1. Both universities accept MBA students from each other for one semester.
2. Conduct joint training of doctoral students.
3. Teachers exchange visits and collaborative research.
4. Retired teachers from Uni-



versity of Warwick come to UIBE for short-term teaching. 5. International management students can come to UIBE for an internship.

The cooperation of the University of Warwick and UIBE began in 2006. A few of UIBE's were accepted into Warwick's program.

The delegation then visited Manchester University's Business School and its Language and Culture School.

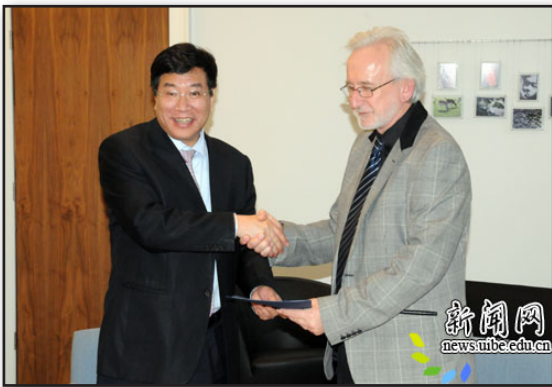

President Shi met with President Martin Hall and both Universities talked about their MBA program and agreed to exchange students in a degree project; they signed a memorandum and both sides discussed the development of logistics and supply chain direction, and a Masters 3 +1 undergraduate program.

The University of Leeds

Dean Zhao Zhongxiu signed an agreement with the Dean of the Business School of the University of Leeds. UIBE's School of International Trade & Economics (SITE) and Business School of the University of Leeds reached two cooperation projects. Hiring Pro. Barkly as UIBE's Changjiang Scholar Professor of International Business and cooperate with the University of Leeds on Banking and Financial Services Research Program.

The University of Birmingham

The delegation then visited the University of Birmingham and discussed cooperation between the two schools. UIBE and Business School reached a con-

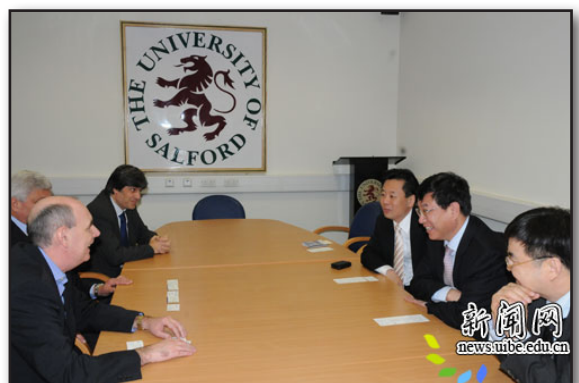
sensus on working on the research in the field of international trade.
