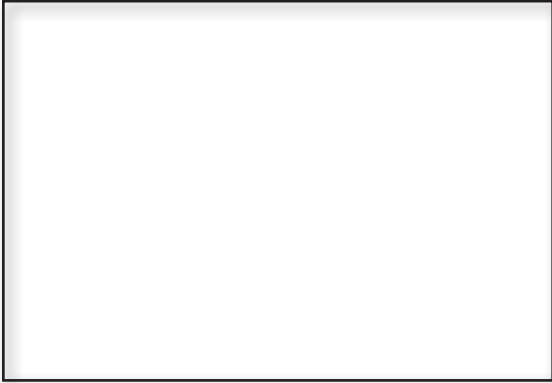
President Shi expressed concern about the development of entrepreneurs within the context of globalization and he hoped countries would use this meeting as an opportunity to build strong academic cooperation.
