### A Delegation from Rutgers University in the US Visits UIBE

On November 17, a delegation from Rutgers Business School (RBS), made up of Professor Rosa Oppenheim, Associate Dean of RBS; and Kelly Brantner, Executive Director of their China Project, visited UIBE and met with UIBE's President, Shi Jianjun.

Rutgers University is located in New Jersey, and is a research university chartered in 1766, currently with more than 53000 students and over 10000 faculty and staff on two main campuses.



Founded in 1929, Rutgers Business School has since 1941 been AACSB International accredited — the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business — a distinction that represents the hallmark of excellence in management education. Recognized as one of the top three business schools in the greater New York metropolitan area; RBS is ranked #8 nationwide for “Best International Business Research School” by the Academy of Management Journal.

During the meeting, RBS began by discussing an EMBA program which they currently carry out in

China. The delegation discussed possible cooperation with UIBE, and once everything is ready in the areas both parties think feasible.

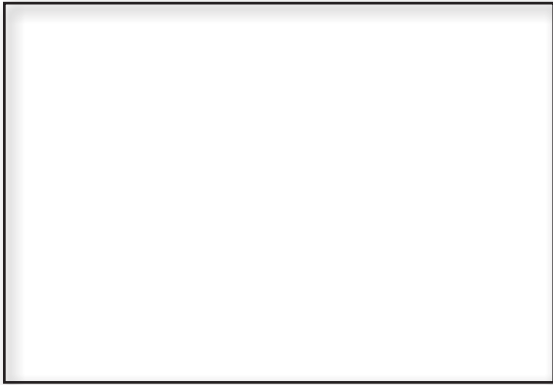
