UIBE changes its top leadership; the University welcomes the new President, and Vice-President.

China's Ministry of Education vice-minister and deputy party secretary, Mr. Chen Xi, announced changes to UIBE's leadership administration during a conference held in the international conference hall, Chengxin Building on June 5, 2009.

Nominated as the new President is Mr. Shi Jianjun, replacing Mr. Chen Zhunmin. Incumbent Vice-Presidents, Mr. Xu Zijian, Mr. Liu Ya, Mr.

Hu Fuyin, Mr. Lin Guijun, were confirmed in their posts; Mr. Zhang Xinmin was appointed Vice-President, replacing Mr. Wang Zhengfu.

Mr. Shi Jianjun was born in October 1955. He was awarded his PhD in economics from

Xiamen University. He worked as Nanjing University's Chief Accountant in 1996, and served Nanjing University's Vice-President from 1997 until 2005. He is a man with a broad overall point of view, clear mind, strong leadership and rich management experience.

Having worked in higher education for many years, he has become quite familiar with the characteristics of higher education in China.

For many years, while at Nanjing University, he was in charge of financial affairs, logistics, development planning and daily administrative affairs. He is equipped with a strong professional capability, and rich academic knowledge, having also served as academic leader in Nanjing University's Business Management School. While at Nanjing University, he also worked as Vice-Chairman of the National Statistical Society of China, and Chairman of Quantity Economics & Management Science Society in Jiangsu Province. UIBE is thankful to the Ministry of Education for the appointment to UIBE of Mr. Shi Jianjun, and proud to have him as its new President.

Vice president Zhang Xinmin was born in 1962. He holds a PhD in Management. In 1983 Mr. Zhang graduated from the Beijing University of Technology with a bachelor's degree in engineering automation. Then in 1989 he obtained a Masters degree in economics from Renmin University,

and in 2001 a PhD in accounting from the Northeast University of Finance and Economics.

He taught in the economics department of the Beijing University of Technology from 1983 till August 1986. He began to teach at UIBE in August 1989, and took the position of Deputy Dean of the School of International Business Administration in September 1994. He was elected Dean of the School of International Business Administration (renamed as Business School in 2005) in December 1999. He was appointed one of the party committee members, and vice president of UIBE in May 2009.

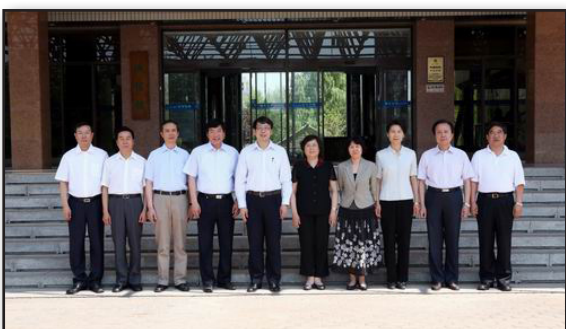
