Vice President Liu Ya Meets with the CEO of Global Association of Risk Professionals

UIBE's Vice President Liu Ya met Richard Apostolik, CEO of GARP (the Global Association of Risk Professionals) and William W. Martin, Chairman of the Board of GARP.

GARP is the world's biggest risk management organization. Its mandate is to promote risk management theory and best practise, improve the quality of practitioners, and to increase awareness of the importance and awareness of risk



management. Every year since 1977 UIBE holds the FRM certification examination; a global authority in the field of financial risk management accreditation.

Vice president Liu Ya warmly welcomed senior leaders from GARP and briefly introduced, mentioning that UIBE is a "Project 211" university, and strives hard to be an international university. UIBE has partnerships with universities, institutions and organizations around the world.

UIBE is home to one of China's top rated Business Schools where Financial risk management is seen as very important. Vice president Liu stated that the biggest challenge for the financial risk management sector is the lack of professional financial risk managers, he hoped that GARP could work with UIBE on increasing the standards of financial risk management in China.

Having expressed interest in China's financial risk management sector, Richard Apostolik mentioned he hoped UIBE and GARP could indeed establish deeper cooperation in the field, and perhaps even establish a branch GARP within UIBE, creating an environment where they could work together in creating specialized training courses and the creation of more FRM exam centers.
