UIBE's President Shi Jianjun named one of "60 Educators in the 60 Years of Education in China" by Sohu.com's Education Annual Festival

By the dead-line of January 31, the Sohu online search engine poll results showed UIBE's President Shi Jianjun named as one of "60 Educators in 60 Years of Education in China".

The poll praises educators who are working to promote the continued progress of China's education system, after 60 years of development.

President of UIBE, Shi Jianjun, who was born in October 1955, is a professor and PhD supervisor. He earned his PhD in business at Xiamen University in 2001. At Nanjing University he started out as Chief Accountant in April, 1996; then Vice President; and finally Executive Vice President.

Dr. Shi also worked as Deputy Director of China's Statistics Association, Deputy Director of Jiangsu Statistics Association, Director of Jiangsu Quantitative and Management Science Center, and Deputy Director of the Jiangsu Science and Technology Management Research Center. He also used to be a Senior Visiting Scholar at Leeds University, Hong Kong Engineering University, and Kansas University, and joined a "Shadow Chancellor" Internship Program at Sydney University and La Trobe University.

Shi has published over 100 academic articles in periodicals like Statistics Research, Economic Theory and Economic Management, Automation News,

Nanjing University Academic Report and China High Education.

He has published 20 books : Comprehensive Evaluation of University Finance; Capital Operation and Risk Prevention Study of High Education Schools; and several Statistics Tutorials.

He has also worked on several Ministry projects: Research on the Comparison of University Finance, Ministry of Education; Contribution of Tourism to the Finance of Jiangsu Province, the Ministry of Finance; Jiangsu Scientific and Technological Progress Monitoring from Jiangsu Science and Technology Department.

Furthermore, he's been part of over 20 national and provincial scientific research projects, and has accepted more than 20 provincial and ministerial teaching and research awards.
