A Visit to UIBE by University of Texas Professor Lian Daxiang to Train Its Teachers

Lian Daxiang, Vice Dean of College of Business of the University of Texas at San Antonio (UTSA) East Asia College, discussed with UIBE teachers how to publish articles in international academic periodicals. The conference was organized by UIBE's International Relations Department and the Student Union. Seventy teacher's attended the meeting.

Party Secretary Wang Ling chaired the conference. She thanked Professor Lian Daxiang for coming again to UIBE, and outlined Professor Lian's educa-



tional and academic background.

This is the second time UIBE organizes such a conference, which represents an important part of UIBE's internationalization efforts.

Professor Lian is the author of around 200 academic papers. He shared his experience with the teachers about how to define an article, find a theme, conduct research and choose the right periodicals for publishing.

Professor Lian advised the teaching staff to pay more attention to the news, and the problems of daily life; as well as create an atmosphere of debate. He also compared the different writing styles of Chinese and



American experts. He also insisted the importance of the high level of English. He also recommended the teachers work in groups and use the library's resources as well as hire local foreign teachers for further training.

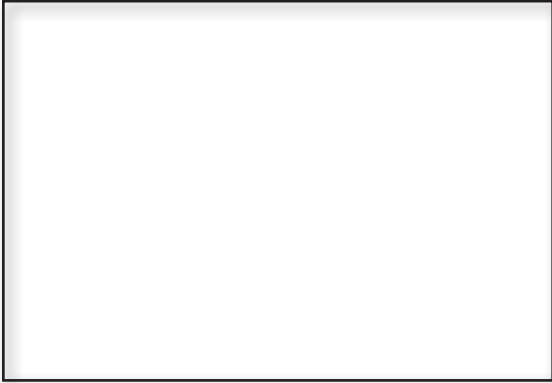
