



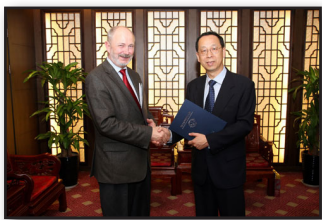

## University of Potsdam Vice President Visits UIBE to Extend the Agreement on Exchange
