

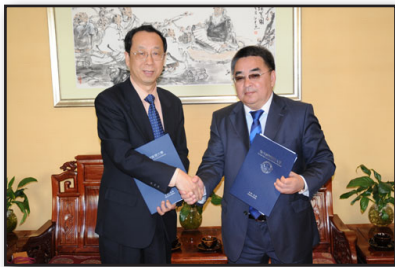

### **UIBE sings a Cooperation Memorandum with the President of Kazakh University**

On April 1, President Chen Zhunmin met professor Amanbaev, President of T. Ryskulov Kazakh Economics University of Kazakhstan, and Mr. Svyator, Chairman of the Board of Economics University. The two universities signed a Cooperation Memorandum.



The presidents of the two universities discussed the construction of universities, economic and social development, as well as the educational systems in both China and Kazakhstan. They agreed to conduct further consultation on relevant fields such as: the exchange of teachers for the purpose of carrying out cooperation, research, and consultation activities; the exchange of students of all levels of study; and mutual recognition of credits for the convenience of students exchange in connected programs at all levels of

study as well as for short-term training for professors and teachers; pushing forward with international training classes for MBA students attending T. Ryskulov Kazakh Economics University; to carry out Double MBA programs in future; and to invite UIBE teachers for teaching of Management, Business, Finance, Economics and Chinese, and to offer on-the-job training classes to senior enterprise managers in Kazakhstan.

T.Ryskulov Kazakh Economics University is the only university in Kazakhstan that specializes in economics, it was formerly a national university. T.Ryskulov Kazakh has turned private following educational reforms introduced in recent years. The university has set up a school board, and gets revenue mostly from tuition and donations. It pays much attention to international cooperation, especially the with China.

After the meeting, the delegation visited the Business School and discussed cooperation in the field of MBA training with Doctor Wang Tiedong, Assistant Dean of School of Business.
