Vice President of UIBE LIN Guijun Met with Dr. Curran, President of University of Dayton (USA)

On behalf of President SHI of UIBE, Vice President of UIBE LIN Guijun met with Dr. Curran, President of University of Dayton (USA) on the morning of Oct 23.



Vice President LIN Guijun welcomed President Curran for his second visit to UIBE and appreciated his great contribution to intensify the cooperation between UIBE and University of Dayton. Dr. Curran said he will encourage students of University of Dayton to come to study in UIBE as he is greatly interested in the UIBE programs that offer all courses in English. Being cautious in selecting cooperation partners and exploring the cooperation fields, University of Dayton would launch exchange programs in different fields with different partners. University of Dayton has carried out the exchange programs in engineering with Nanjing University and the exchange programs in business or other humanities with UIBE. Dr. Curran added that besides the short-term learning program, he will encourage the graduate students of University of Dayton to do their graduate work in UIBE. Thanks

to the efforts made by Dr. Curran, University of Dayton will send her Director of Department of International Affairs to visit UIBE on Oct 26 and her Dean of Business School on Nov 6, in order to talk over the details of student exchange with UIBE counterparts.

It was agreed that the students exchange is to be implemented in the following ways: 1) the students would be enrolled in the recipient university as “visiting students” and enjoy relevant rights. The tuition is payable to the recipient university; 2) the students of UIBE who go to University of Dayton for short-term study will enjoy tuition discount with a rate to be fixed with negotiation between the two universities; 3) University of Dayton will pay the tuition and maintenance of her students who come to study in UIBE; 4) The students of UIBE could go to University of Dayton for one semester or one academic year study, with the time and the content of study being determined by UIBE.

After the meeting, Vice President LIN Guijun was invited to talk through the telephone with Dr. Shank, Dean of Business School at University of Dayton. Dr. Shank suggested UIBE students could spend one semester studying in University of Dayton and the other semester participating in internship in USA for the improvement of practical competency under the arrangement of University of Dayton. LIN was pleased at this suggestion and invited Dr. Shank to visit UIBE sometime.

WANG Tiedong, Assistant to the Dean of Business School; XIANG Jie, Director of Department of International Affairs; and Sherry, Manager of International MBA Project of Business School at UIBE attended the meeting.
