Professor Ronald Schramm of University of Columbia (USA) visits UIBE

On the morning of October 16, LIN Guijun, Vice President of UIBE, held a talk with Dr. Ronald Schramm, Professor of Economics of University of Columbia (USA) who came to visit UIBE, mainly concentrating on carrying out cooperative research between Dr. Schramm and the teachers of UIBE in the fields of consumption economics, industrial economics, institutional economics and intellectual property protection. Mr. Xia Haiquan, Director of Department of International Cooperation and Exchange; and Xu Yiping, Associate Professor of School of International Trade and Economics, UIBE were presented at the talk.

Vice President LIN expressed his gratitude to Dr. Schramm for his long commitment to the teaching, cooperative research and academia exchange of UIBE and hoped Dr. Schramm further his academic cooperation with UIBE teachers, bringing higher research level of young and middle-aged scholars of UIBE and accordingly more theses to be published worldwide. They discussed further on the joint research of consumption economics and reached a consensus on co-authoring relevant theses.

Following the talk, Professor Schramm came to SITE and met with Professor ZHAO Zhongxiu, Dean of SITE. Then they held a talk together with professors of SITE including Professor Sun Huayu, Professor Gong Jiongfu and Professor Hong Junjie, concerning the research in the fields of industrial economics, institutional economics and intellectual property protection. The talks proved to be fruitful and the two parties said they will make further discussion on the research topics both them are interested in and co-author the academic theses.

Ronald Schramm, a Harvard graduate of 1976, is a professor of economics of University of Columbia (USA), now carrying on his teaching and research work in China Europe International Business School. He is familiar to us since he served as Fulbright Professor in UIBE from 2002 and 2003, arising unanimous favorable comments among teachers and students. Vice President LIN being his coauthor, Dr. Schramm has published many theses such as "A Decade of Flow of Funds in China (1995-2006)" and "Chinese capital markets --- out of the shadows" in some well-known economics periodicals, for example, the notable "Economist".
